Student Schedules- Schedules will be made by your child's counselor. Standardized test scores and report card grades will be the primary tools for determining your child's class placement. Your child will receive their schedule on their first day of school.

Student ID- Every student must have their student ID with them at all times. ID's are primarily used for lunch and checking out books at the media center. Replacement ID's cost \$5 in the Media Center.

PE class- PE uniforms are mandatory. Uniforms and PE lockers can be purchased. Costs are: \$10 shirt, \$10 shorts, and \$10 to share a locker with a lock. See your PE teacher to purchase these items and for questions regarding lockers and uniforms.

Bus Transportation- In general if you live 2+ miles away from school, your child qualifies for a bus. To find your bus stop, pickup/drop off times please visit www.ocps.net and click on "find a bus". It is especially important that your child knows their bus number prior to the first day of school.

Code of Conduct- The OCPS Code of Conduct describes the rules that all students must follow. The OCPS Code of Conduct can be found on the students Canvas page or at codeofconduct.ocps.net. Your counselor will provide the student with this document. Students will acknowledge the Student Code of Conduct electronically within the 1st week of entry.

Lunch – Current OCPS students: If you are transferring to Lake Nona from an OCPS school your lunch account will transfer over automatically. Lunch prices will be the same as your previous middle school. **Non OCPS students:** To be considered for free or reduced lunch prices, please complete a lunch form at www.ocpsmealapp.com. It will take approximately 1 week for your lunch application to be processed. A full priced lunch costs \$2.75 and includes 1 entrée, 2 sides and a milk.
