## CORE COURSES CONTINUED

- Final Placement decisions:
  - Placement decisions for all core classes will be made once final grades are earned and 2021 FSA results come back.
  - High School level courses ALL prerequisites must be met for students to be placed into high school level course.
    - Algebra I Honors (HS)
    - Geometry Honors(HS)
    - Physical Science Honors (HS)
- High School courses:
  - Counts as one of your credits towards high school graduation
  - Grade earned stays on your permanent high school transcript
  - Will have an End of Course (EOC) Exam or a Common Final Exam (CFE)





## SELECTING ELECTIVE COURSES

- Elective requests will be taken into consideration; however elective classes are not guaranteed based on class size, course availability, and number of course requests.
- Performing Arts: Students will be placed based on experience and teacher recommendation.
  - Jazz Band will be in addition to a primary band class, meaning all students in this class will have two periods of band.
- To be placed in a high school foreign language course, the student must be on grade level in their Reading/Writing FSA.

## **ELECTIVE COURSES CONTINUED**

#### FRIENDLY REMINDERS:

- Electives are subject to change!
- Physical Education PE will take one of your elective spots as this is a requirement in middle school.
- Intensive Reading Students may be placed in an Intensive Reading course due to school and district guidelines. Intensive Reading will take the place of one your elective classes.
- High School Foreign Language (HS) Students must be on grade level in their Reading/Writing FSA (Level 3 or higher) in order to be eligible to take this high school level course.
- Performing Arts Students will be placed in the various performing arts levels based on teacher recommendation.
- Elective Requests Requests will be taken into consideration. However, elective classes are not guaranteed and are based on class size, course availability, and number of course requests.


